



2012 High School Outreach Scholarship Program

Consolidated School of Business is proud to offer the High School Outreach Scholarship. Eligible applicants will be 2012 high school graduates from Lancaster or York area High Schools.

Each year both Lancaster CSB and York CSB offer outreach scholarships to area high school seniors who plan to enter CSB in pursuit of an Associate in Specialized Business degree.

Each campus will award six need-based and/or merit-based scholarships equal to fifty percent (50%) of the total tuition* for each academic year of an ASB degree program.

Scholarship Details:

- Six (6) scholarships per campus will be awarded.
- Recipient must enroll as a full-time student in a CSB Associate in Specialized Business (ASB) degree program, maintain 80% or better classroom attendance, and meet or exceed CSB's minimum academic progress standards as outlined in the CSB catalog.
- Scholarship value will be up to 50% of total tuition* for an ASB degree program, awarded on an academic year basis and prorated on a term-by-term basis.
- Recipient must begin classes no later than November 12, 2012.
- All books and program fees will be the responsibility of the student.
- All future scholarship payments will be forfeited if recipient does not meet the minimum CGPA or attendance criteria, withdraws from his or her program of study, drops below full-time status, or fails to meet all requirements outlined in CSB's Academic Progress Policy.
- Student must meet the criteria as outlined on the CSB High School Outreach Merit-Based/Need-Based Scholarship application.
- An independent review panel will select the scholarship winners from the applicant pool.
- Please complete the appropriate application(s) on the following pages. Deadline for receipt of the application by CSB will be April 2, 2012.
- An independent panel will review all applications and make its selection by April 16, 2012. Recipients will be notified by mail.
- Recipients will have fourteen (14) days to notify CSB of their acceptance of the scholarship. If a recipient chooses to decline the award or fails to notify CSB within the required time frame, the committee will award that scholarship to the next highest qualifier.

*The value of the scholarship will be 50% of the total tuition charge for each academic year except where the total of the CSB scholarship combined with any other grants or scholarships would exceed the total cost of tuition for an academic year, in which case the CSB scholarship would be reduced accordingly. However, in no case would the total value of the scholarship be less than 25% of the full tuition of an academic year for an Associate in Specialized Business degree.

2. Must submit with this application at least one letter of recommendation from a school and/or a community representative.
3. Must satisfy **one or more** of the following conditions: **Circle all conditions that apply.**
 - a. Parental Adjusted Gross Income is less than \$30,000 for the most recent tax year filed.
 - b. Either parent is a documented dislocated worker (currently receiving unemployment compensation) at the time of the application.
 - c. Neither parent has attended a business, trade, technical school or a two or four-year college.
 - d. Either parent is serving in the armed forces at the time of the application.
 - e. Either parent has died or is considered disabled as a result of service in the armed forces, law enforcement, or fire protection.

Please provide with this application suitable documentation for items "a" through "e" which may include most recent Federal 1040, 1040A, or 1040 EZ tax returns, unemployment compensation documents such as Benefit Payment Information or Notice of Financial Determination, a signed statement from parents attesting to the fact that they have had no post-secondary attendance, and military or medical documents to support items "d" or "e."
